Your role includes being vigilant and approachable as children and adults might come to you for help.

Always act in the best interest of the child or vulnerable person.

Technical Officials

ALWAYS report missing children or persons to the Safeguarding Lead immediately. Stay calm and gather key info: name, age, description, last seen. Stay at your post unless told otherwise. Don't search alone or spread information publicly.

If you have a concern: **Record it, act on it, and never assume.**

Refer to the next slide for information on how to handle a concern.

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✓ DO:

- Stay calm and reassure the individual.
- Follow confidentiality guidelines – explain that you need to share the concern to help protect them.
- Ensure the immediate safety of the individual.
- Record what you've seen or heard and **report it to the Safeguarding Lead.**

✗ DON'T:

- Rush into action or try to fix it yourself.
- Show strong emotions or make promises you can't keep.
- Keep it to yourself – always refer the concern appropriately.
- Speculate, assume, or question in detail.
- Ask leading questions – use open-ended ones only to clarify.
- Promise to keep things secret.
- Attempt to investigate – that's not your role.
